Held in Malmo, Sweden, the event featured over 1000 delegates from across the world, presenting on Sport Science and the Politics and Sociology of Sport.

Our paper was titled “Attitudes to Sustainability Amongst English Football Fans” and was very well received. We are currently working on an article which will expand on the findings discussed in the paper. We were part of a panel that examined issues of sustainability in global football, and featured colleagues from Norway, Professor [Roy Krovel](#) (Oslo and Akershus University College of Applied Sciences) and Dr Nina Lager Vestberg (Norwegian University of Science and Technology). Conference President Dr Aage Radmann of Malmo University also presented a very interesting paper on Ultra movements and sustainability, and Dr Ary Rocco Jr of the University of Sao Paulo presented on coverage of female athletes in the Brazilian media.
